IMPOUNDING OF ANIMALS

Animals are impounded at Geelong Animal Welfare Society (GAWS).

After **EIGHT (8) DAYS** unclaimed animals may be adopted, sold or euthanased.

POUND RELEASES

- The prescribed fees payable to GAWS must be paid prior to release.
- Animals will only be released during normal operating hours.
- Additional prescribed fees are payable to Council following release.
- All animals need to be currently registered before release.

IMPORTANT NOTICE DOG OWNERS

YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES AS THE OWNER OF A DOG OR CAT

- * Proof of microchipping is required for all new animal registrations.
- * All dogs must be securely confined to your property and wear their registration tags at all times.
- * Dogs must be leashed at all times within the Borough of Queenscliffe unless being exercised in a designated 'off leash' area.
- * Your dog or cat must not cause a nuisance.
- * Your dog or cat must wear the Registration Tag provided at all times, to ensure ownership of the animal can be quickly traced.
- * If a dog rushes at or chases any person the owner is guilty of an offence.
- * CATS must be securely confined to their owners premises between 8.00pm (eastern standard time) or 9.00pm (daylight saving time) and 6.00am daily penalty up to \$740.00.
- * CATS (other than restrained domestic cats) are prohibited in public areas in the municipality.
- * All cats must be desexed prior to registration as required by the Domestic Animals Act.
- * All cats and dogs over three months must be registered.
- * It is the responsibility of the dog owner to remove and dispose of their dogs waste when in public places.
