

Future Development of Queenscliff High School Site

The site of the former Queenscliff High School is an outstanding community asset that announces the entrance to Queenscliff and heralds commanding views over Swan Bay.

At its November meeting, Council resolved to seek community feedback and submissions regarding the future development of the former high school site, requesting comments on two proposed development scenarios;

- (1) Continue to maintain the site with little or no change,
- (2) Develop the site as a Botanic Garden and high value parkland, which include Indigenous Gardens and a Community Vegetable Garden with associated infrastructure and develop a community building.

Council also resolved that any potential future project costs would be substantially funded from existing State Government grants.

The Borough of Queenscliffe values community views and your submission will play an important role in determining the future development of this significant community asset.

The proposed Botanic Gardens would include the following components:

- Retain existing open space on western portion of site
- Extensive new plantings on the eastern portion of the site
- Expansion of the Indigenous Garden
- Establishment of a Community Vegetable Garden
- Inclusion of park infrastructure. This could include barbecues, improved parking, park furniture (picnic tables, benches), shelter, storage facilities (for equipment), paths.
- Construction of a community building (including public access toilets)
