

Borough's 150th Anniversary Celebrations



Title:	Governor Visit and Civic Reception
Estimated cost:	\$5,000
Description:	Governor of Victoria to visit the Borough. A morning tea and civic reception will be held at the Queenscliff Town Hall. Guests are by invitation only.

Title:	Heritage Attractions Open House Weekend
Estimated cost:	\$6,000 Donation
Description:	The heritage attractions to be open to the public free of charge for both days over the celebration weekend. The aim is to encourage locals and visitors to the attractions and gain a better understanding of the history of the area. The focus will be on Fort Queenscliff, the Maritime Museum (including lighthouses), Historical Museum and Bellarine Railway.

Title:	Community Celebration Concert
Estimated cost:	\$20,000
Description:	A community celebration concert with a focus on family and music. Other activities will include jumping castle, face painting and food vendors.

Title:	Projections Project
Estimated cost:	\$5,000
Description:	Matt Bonner, artist and film maker, will be engaged to extend his 2012 Artist in Residence project of manipulating and animating local images sourced from each of the three local museums and projecting them onto buildings of historical significance.

Title:	Old Time Films of Queenscliff and Point Lonsdale
Estimated cost:	\$3,000
Description:	Screenings of old black and white films of Queenscliff and Point Lonsdale supplied by Ron Hodgett and the Queenscliffe Historical Museum.

Title:	Lighthouse Theatre Re-enactment
Estimated cost:	\$10,000
Description:	Re-enactment theme to be finalised.

Title: Family History school curriculum and Artist in Residence program
Estimated cost: Funded from Council's Community Development program
Description: Theme 'Every family has shaped this community'. Working with local schools to identify and artistically portray students' family history and generations in the Borough. The works will be on exhibition at the Queenscliff Library.

Title: 150th Time Capsule
Estimated cost: \$2,000 and co-funded by Council's works program
Description: Time Capsule to be announced in December 2012, including location of its burial. This will allow the community five months to collate items to be included in the capsule before it's buried on Sunday 5 May 2013.

Title: 150th Anniversary Pictorial History Book
Estimated cost: \$5,000
Description: A pictorial history book of the Borough of Queenscliffe as allocated to John Reid under agreed arrangements.

Title: Historical Photographer Boards and Promotional Brochure
Estimated cost: \$5,000
Description: A series of Historical Photographers Boards based on the images of photographers Ormerod and Kruger, with accompanying brochure.

Title: Launch of the Wadda Wurun Dja Ngawa information booklet
Estimated cost: \$5,000
Description: A 'Did you know...?' information booklet detailing the history and facts of the local Indigenous culture.

Title: 150th Anniversary Art Acquisition Award
Estimated cost: \$10,000
Description: The inaugural Arts Acquisition Award. Categories will include Open (major), Local (minor) and Junior (minor) and an exhibition of entries. The winning art work to be acquired for permanent display in the Borough Offices.

Title: 150th Official Merchandise Design
Estimated cost: \$5,000
Description: Develop design to suit a range of official souvenirs such as bookmarks, postcards, lapel pins, spoons, keying's and commemorative newspaper

Total budget allocation: \$100,000
