- Current Registered Organisation membership card must be produced each year.

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RESTRICTED DOG BREEDS

The Domestic Animals Act 1994 requires specific control to the keeping of "RESTRICTED BREED DOGS". State Government has made legislation to restrict the following dog breeds:

AMERICAN PIT BULL TERRIER

- JAPANESE TOSA

DOGO ARGENTINO

- PERRO DE PRESA CANARIO

A person who fails to declare a restricted breed dog is liable to an infringement notice under the Domestic Animals Act 1994 or prosecution in the Magistrates Court.

Privacy Notification: The information provided on this form is subject to Section 18 of the Domestic Animals Act 1994 and will be used to update the public animals register as prescribed under that Act.

RESPONSIBLE PET OWNERSHIP

- * Proof of microchipping is required for all new animal registrations.
- * All dogs must be securely confined to your property and wear their registration tags at all times.
- Dogs must be leashed at all times within the Borough of Queenscliffe unless being exercised at the Dog Beach designated 'off leash' area.
- * Your dog or cat must not cause a nuisance.
- Your dog or cat must wear the Registration Tag provided at all times, to ensure ownership of the animal can be quickly traced.
- * If a dog rushes or chases any other person, the owner is liable for a dog rush offence under the Domestic Animals Act 1994.
- * Cats are prohibited in public areas within the municipality at least safely restrained or contained.
- All cats must be desexed prior to registration as required by the Domestic Animals Act 1994.
- * All cats and dogs over three months must be registered.
- It is the responsibility of the dog owner to remove and dispose of their dogs waste when in public places.

Cats must be securely confined to their owners premises between 8.00pm (eastern standard time) or 9.00pm (daylight saving time) and 6.00am daily - penalties apply.
