All social housing is subsidised by the Government and provided to support households who need affordable housing because of very low income. Otherwise, these households would pay more than 30% of their income, just for housing.

In the G21 region the Victorian Government are planning to spend at least **\$215 million** on social housing across the region, **\$180 million** in the City of Greater Geelong alone.

The City of Greater Geelong has already completed a comprehensive long term plan and the other four Councils are working on plans to identify and meet community needs.

SHAPING THE BIG HOUSING BUILD IN THE G21 REGION

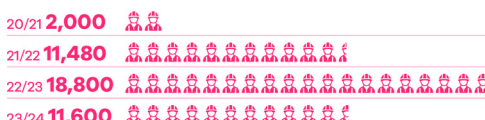
The Victorian Government has committed **\$5.3 billion** over the next four years to build social housing and employ people in the construction industry. This is called the Big Housing Build and will be delivered by Homes Victoria.

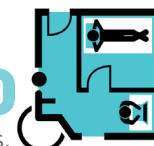
